

Vocational education on Industry 4.0 matter us!

How did the international comparison of vocational education and training (VET) processes in areas relevant to "Industry 4.0" turn out, and what will be the recommendations for their improvement?

ConPlusUltra GmbH together with the partners of the EDU4future project from Germany, the Czech Republic, Austria, Italy, Slovakia and Slovenia processed the Comparative Analysis on adaptation processes of VET in the field of "Industry 4.0" and a set of recommendations for their improvement.

The main guarantor for the compilation of the Comparative Analysis is a Czech partner which specializes in labor market analysis services, the [TREXIMA](#) Zlín. The comparative analysis is compiled from the national reports of 6 countries. The partners discussed the first results of the comparative analysis in May of this year at a partner meeting in Austria. Currently, based on this comparative analysis, the Austrian partner [ConPlusUltra](#) is coordinating the processing of draft recommendations for improving VET processes with a focus on incorporating Industry 4.0 requirements into educational curricula. Partners draw on identified barriers, examples of best practices, and comments from an external survey to draft recommendations.

A comprehensive presentation of all the outputs of the international project EDU4future will be held on November 9, 2022 at the final conference "[Vocational education on Industry 4.0 matter us!](#)" in the Volkswagen AUTO FORUM premises in Bratislava (Slovakia). In Austria the stakeholder event where recommendations with Austrian relevance were formulated, was held on 13th Oktober at Firma Geberit.

Participants from the most important regional companies and responsible social partners discussed the future of apprenticeship training with regard to Industry 4.0 and digitalisation. Finally, recommendations for action were derived, which will be incorporated into the results of the project and presented in Bratislava.
